 - i. Drachman's Title 1 Budget will be cut by \$71,482.

 - iii. Drachman's Maintenance and Operations Budget will increase by approximately \$100,000 to fund a full time PE teacher and full time Response to Intervention Teacher.

 - iv. TUSD is reviewing the staffing formulas for Attendance Technicians based on student enrollment and Ms. Mohammad is aware.
 - 1. Schools with smaller populations might be losing that position or might have to split between two schools.
 - v. All staff that are not retiring are able to return for next school year. 😊
